

Communication and Language

The children will use a range of different methods to develop their skills of communicating; working individually, with a buddy, in groups and as a whole class.

These will take place as part of our everyday learning across the curriculum.

I.C.T and Computer Science

We will cover programming, e-safety, ways of creating and presenting ideas and information as well as developing our keyboard and typing skills.

French

The children will be developing their spoken language to describe modes of transport, directions and points of the compass.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

PSHE - we will be thinking about the importance of positive relationships and our themes for the term: generosity and respect.

R.E - we will study the values and beliefs of Christians and Jews. We will celebrate Harvest and discuss its significance to the local area., as well as celebrating the birth of Jesus at Christmas.

Literacy

Year 3 and 4 will be finding out about the Great Fire of London and Year 5 and 6 will be studying the Titanic. Learning will cover newspaper reports, letters, leaflets recounts, diary entries and stories of survivors.

Spelling, punctuation and grammar will also be taught on a weekly basis in each class. We will be developing our sign language skills with Makaton lessons

Design and Technology -we will explore items made out of recycled materials and design and make our own bags.
